Greetings Cedric and Welcome to Mahogany.

M.M.R: How long have you been writing poetry?

C.M.: I've been writing poetry seriously since 1995, but I wrote my first poem at 1985.

M.M.R: How many Poetry books do you have published?

listener is remarkable. It's like your struggling between good and evil. Trying to move from the darkness of the past into the light.

All your poems are wonderful but my favorites are" I The Paper....Unfold Me,

Ironic, Locked Down, Your Return, For Me,"

The Univer-Soul Language is a nice collection. I was impressed by the first poem "Love Letters" by Sharia Kharif. All the poets are outstanding. You can relate with the words. This is a really nice collection Cedric. And the C.d. is just as good. The music doesn't drown out the voice like it does in some other spoken word C.d.'s.

C.M.: There will be another volume coming soon, however we don't currently have a date.
